## Recommendations

- ✓ Crop extractions in kg of nutrients for every 1,000 kg of dry material:

N	P <sub>2</sub> O <sub>5</sub>	K <sub>2</sub> O
25	13	18

- ✓ Administer aphid-control treatment if needed.
